







General Learning Difficulties





If you have a general learning difficulty you may find it hard to:

	<p>Understand instructions and information</p>
	<p>Remember things that have happened</p>
	<p>Listen to others and concentrate on things</p>
	<p>Keep organised</p>
	<p>Read and write</p>
	<p>Make links between information</p>

How can schools and colleges help you if you have a General Learning Difficulty?

Teachers can:

	<p>Help you plan answers to questions</p>
	<p>Offer you different ways to do your work such as using a computer or making a mind map</p>
	<p>Give you instructions in stages</p>
	<p>Write up instructions and talk you through them</p>
	<p>Repeat information and instructions</p>
	<p>Remind you to listen when you are being told what to do</p>
	<p>Check that you are understanding what you are being asked to do</p>

	<p>Show you how to do your work and find different ways for you to work if you don't understand</p>
	<p>Help you stay on track by praising good work</p>
	<p>Remind you to bring the right books and equipment to lessons</p>
	<p>Correct spelling mistakes</p>
	<p>Explain how you can make your work better</p>
	<p>Help you to read worksheets and stories</p>
