
Leicester City Council provides social care and special educational needs transport for:






	<p>Some children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities</p>
	<p>Looked after children</p>
	<p>Certain children and young people attending school or college</p>
	<p>Adults with special or medical needs</p>

	<p>The Council has its own drivers and buses but also works with transport companies</p>

If you meet the assessment criteria Leicester City Council transport can be used to take:


	<p>Children to hospital, schools and overnight short breaks</p>

	<p>Children from where they are living to meet their parents</p>
	<p>Trips for special needs schools and day time activities</p>
	<p>Certain adults travelling from home to day care or to community centres</p>
	<p>Certain adults with special needs to work placements</p>
	<p>There is also a dial-a-ride service for people with special and medical needs who can't use public transport</p>

	<p>Parents who have a special educational needs parent contract with Leicester City Council can claim back the cost for transport.</p>
